

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the tine carriage hoisting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type blade carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades can differ by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
