As opposed to the quick-tach bucket models, universal fit buckets are fifty percent. This additional room makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads like for instance moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.
