Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store employing only four people. Overall sales for that particular year amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and different parts. During 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to forty employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. Nowadays, Cascade is amongst the top international producers within the material handling trade.

Production and design of the company's first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business opportunities. Over the past 60 years, the material handling trade has matured into a highly advanced area and Cascade has proudly performed a part on this progress. Cascade currently continues to develop as the best supplier of lift truck accessories and numerous associated items. The company feels confident in their skill to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's needs in the future and remaining competitive within the international market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade began designing, manufacturing and advertising hydraulic accessories. Construction was finished in 1956 on a brand new office to house all of the plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current center of operations. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total workers reached 180 staff and sales had reached nearly 2.3 million dollars.

A second production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the global world of the material handling industry while the company established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

The company altered its name to Cascade Corporation in 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its production facilities within the United States with places in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Ohio, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade products are fabricated worldwide because of numerous subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This facility is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to buying five firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global leader in forks.
